Constitution of India, 1950 — Art. 226 — Delhi School Education Rules, 1973 — Rule 46 — Closure of School : School unable to adhere to pay scales recommended by fifth Pay Commission : Matter pending for several months in office of Director of Education : No reasons given for refusal to grant permission to close down school : Dispute regarding non-payment of dues to teachers/employees not one of reasons for declining approval : Impugned order of statutory authority not self-contained or self-explanatory : School deemed to be closed w.e.f. passing of orders, *i.e.* in July, 1998 : Further observations made.
